

Elkins Dance Team Classroom Procedures *Dance II-IV*

Supplies Needed

- 1" white 3-ring binder with clear plastic cover
- 5 Dividers
- Pen/Pencil
- 1 Box of Kleenex

Be on time to class. Students are required to be in the dance room by the time the tardy bell rings (1:41 p.m.). A discipline referral will be written on the students 3rd tardy and every other tardy thereafter. Students who are late to the dance room will be required to sign in on a tardy sheet. Students may dress in the dance team dressing room only and must be in the assigned roll call lines by 1:50 p.m.

Late passes. Teachers do not write passes if you are late leaving class. If you choose to stay in the classroom and work after the bell, you must take a tardy to your next class.

Absences. If you have been absent, you are responsible for all assignment you have missed.

Care of school owned equipment. You have been issued a school owned uniform. It is your responsibility to keep that uniform in excellent condition. After the spring show, you will be required to have all 7 school issued uniform pieces dry cleaned by TIME WISE CLEANERS on Hwy. 6. The uniforms must be turned in on the designated days in the dry cleaning bag with the receipt attached. Failure to return all assigned uniform pieces in proper condition will result in a fee being charged.

You will be issued a school owned lock and given a locker to utilize for the year. You will be responsible for returning the lock or paying \$5.00 to replace the lock at the end of the year. Additionally, you will be issued other items throughout the year. Proper check-out and check-in procedures will be discussed at the time of issue.

Other procedures. All guidelines set forth in the student handbook and Elite Dance Team Handbook will apply for the entire year.

Grading procedures. A students dance class grade will be based on participation (50%) and written/handed in work (25%) and on dance skills (25%). Participation grades will include proper dress and classroom activity. Written and handed in work may include turning in documents/uniforms on time, written routine notes, notebooks, etc. Skills tests will be given and graded periodically throughout each grading period.

Merit/Demerit information. Demerits will be issued during roll call...jewelry, cover-ups, etc. will be counted as improper attire starting at 1:50 p.m. each day. Allowances for cover-ups may be made as the weather changes and should these changes occur, students will be notified in writing.
